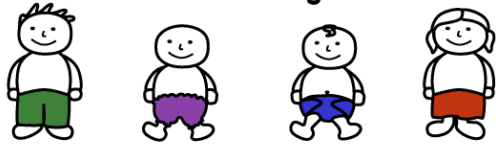

Tip: Did you know that reading the same book again and again is good for your child’s brain? Children learn more new words if one story is read to them repeatedly, than if several stories are read only once.

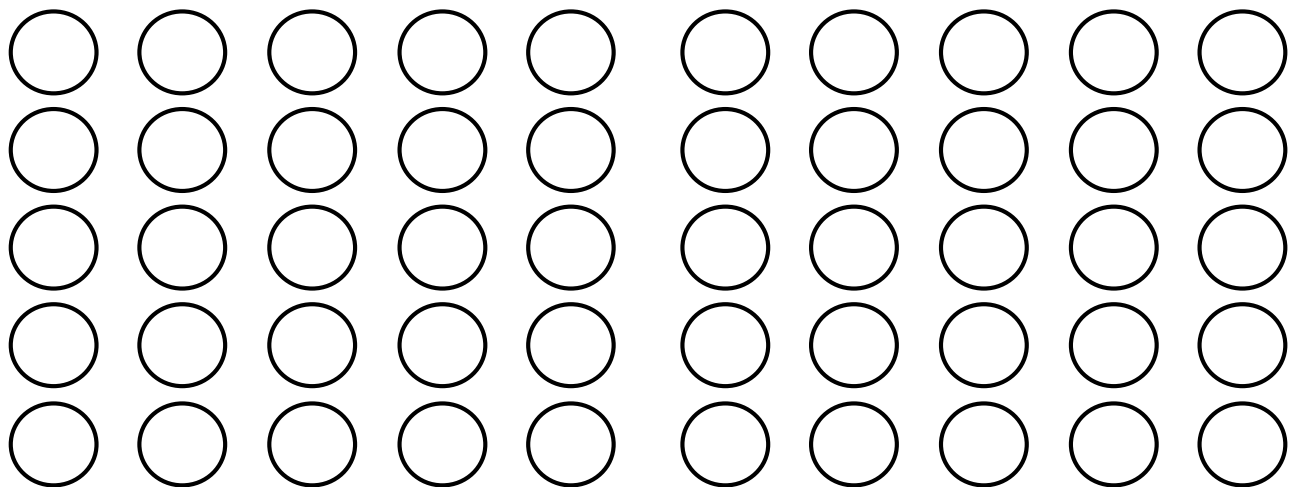
