



Annual Gingerbread House Contest

Rules:

- Contest is open to all ages. The separate prize categories are:
 - Preschool (5 and younger)
 - Children (Grade 5 and younger)
 - Teens (Grades 6-12)
 - Adult and Groups/Families
- Any gingerbread structure is eligible for entry.
- Create a 10x14 inch (max) gingerbread house or scene.
- Gingerbread kits are allowed.
- Entries must have been constructed in 2021.
- Gingerbread structure must be the dominant feature of the entry.
- The majority of structure components must be edible.
- All entries must be submitted with an entry form.
- A prize will be awarded for each division as well as the People's Choice Award.
- The Gingerbread House Committee reserves the right to omit any entry that is deemed inappropriate.

Important Dates:

- November 29 – December 7: completed entries must be delivered to the library
- December 8-16: All voting & judging (in the library and online)
- December 17: Winners announced
- December 31: All entries must be picked up
