Rules:

- Any gingerbread structure is eligible for entry.
- Gingerbread kits are allowed as long as additions have been made to your kit.
- Create a gingerbread house or scene with a max base of 10"x14".
- Entries must have been constructed in 2024.
- Gingerbread structure must be the dominant feature of the entry.
- The majority of structure components must be edible.
- All entries must be submitted with an entry form.
- A prize will be awarded for each division as well as People's Choice Award.
- The Gingerbread House Committee reserves the right to omit any entry that is deemed inappropriate.
- Contest is open to all ages. The separate prize categories are: Children (Grade 5 and younger), Teens (Grades 6-12) Adults, and Groups/Families.



Important Dates:

- Entries must be delivered to the library in completed form between Nov 25-Dec 4 (library closed Nov 28-30).
- The entries will be displayed until Dec 5-13.
- Judging will take place Dec 5-11. Winners announced Dec 12.
- If you want to pick up your entry after the contest, please do so Dec 13-17. All entries left after Dec 17 will be thrown.
